### Definition of "ASR":

This is Azure Site Recovery, a protection strategy that creates copies of the IT infrastructure of an entire location (branch office, main office, satellite office etc.) somewhere else, so that if the original site goes offline a copy of that site can be quickly spun up to replace it without losing productivity.

### Definition of "DR":

Disaster Recovery is a strategy for backing up important data, like files, folders, and virtual machines to safe locations (like the cloud or another datacentre) that offer high availability and redundancy.

### Definition of "Third Party Backup Solutions":

Backup software supplied by a vendor that isn't Microsoft, but which are compatible with Azure Backup.

### Definition of "SQL Database":

SQL is a programming language that talks to databases; databases are stores of information that have been arranged logically.

### Definition of "SAP HANA":

A high-performance database engine that analyses big data sets in real time.

### Definition of "Azure File shares":

A type of storage in Azure that can be used as a central repository for files that can be easily shared across your organisation.
