

Excellent Email


Microsoft 365 offers the most generous email storage allocation on the market today. Through Exchange Online, an integral component of Microsoft 365, businesses get:

Competing services limit their inbox sizes to 30GB or less, don't throw in unlimited archiving storage, and limit the size of emails that can be sent to 50MB or less.

Microsoft positions PowerApps as 'a suite of apps, services, connectors, and data platform that provides a rapid application development application to build custom apps for your business needs'.

The beauty of PowerApps is that they do not require knowledge of how to write code to build useful business applications – the process of creating apps this way is more like building a slide deck in PowerPoint. The applications built with PowerApps can run on mobile devices and inside browsers, making deployment incredibly fast and easy.

PowerApps are included with all Microsoft 365 packages from Microsoft 365 Business Standard and up.
